December 1st

Theodore Roosevelt was the first American to win the Nobel Peace Prize, 1906

December 2nd

The Monroe Doctrine was announced, 1823

December 3rd

The first American flag was raised aboard the "USS Alfred," 1775

General Washington bade farewell to his troops, 1783

December 15th

The Bill of Rights went into effect, 1791

The movie, "Gone With The Wind" premiered, 1939

December 16th

The Boston Tea Party occurred, 1773

World War II Battle of the Bulge, which was the last major German offensive of the war began, when German forces broke through Allied defenses in the Ardennes. 1944

December 17th

France recognized American independence, 1777
