# February 1st

•Thomas Jefferson's "Monticello" construction began, 1769

# February 4th

•George Washington was appointed President of the Constitutional Convention, 1782

•The Confederate States of America formed, 1861

# February 6th

•Robert E. Lee was named general-in-chief of the Confederate Army, 1865

# February 8th

•The Boy Scouts of America was incorporated, 1910; brought to the USA by Dr William Boyce.

# February 10th

•The National Executive Board approves the Cub program "controlled experiment"; Packs can register with the BSA starting April 1, 1930 (5,102 boys, 1,433 pack leaders and 243 packs are registered in 1930 the first year), 1930

# February 13th

•New Federal Ironclad "Indianola" began its journey, 1863

# February 14th

•American ship "Ranger" carried the Stars and Stripes to a foreign port for the first time as it arrived in France, 1778

# February 16th

•General Ulysses S. Grant earned his nickname of "Unconditional Surrender Gra following the surrender of Confederates at Ft. Donelson, 1862

#### February 17th

- •A Baltimore street was first to be lighted with gas, from the America's first gas company, 1817
- Provisional Confederate Congress held its last meeting, 1862
- The first ship passed through Suez Canal, 1867

# February 18th

Jefferson Davis was made the provisional President of the Confederacy, 1861

# February 19th

•Navy Distinguished Service Medal authorized, 1919

# February 20th

- •President George Washington signed an act creating the United States Post Office, 1792
- •Astronaut John Glenn, became the first American to orbit the Earth aboard the Friendship VII Mercury capsule, 1962

# February 21st

The Washington Monument was dedicated, 1885

# February 22nd

Jefferson Davis was inaugurated as President of the Confederacy, 1862

# February 23rd

•The Battle at the Alamo began, 1836

# February 24th

•Supreme Court overturned United States law for first time, 1803 •United States soldiers liberated Manila from Japan, 1945

# February 25th

Samuel Colt, patented his revolver, 1836

# February 27th

•The District of Columbia was placed under the jurisdiction of Congress, 1801
