To Qualify:

1. **Registrations must be paid on or before May 6.**

2. Find at least 8 Cub Scouts to attend camp the same week NEW for 2021 - Lunch is included in the price!

3. Work with your Pack camping coordinator to fill out the registration for each Camper using the Pack account at www.erieshorescouncil.org/cdc and add the registrations to the cart but do not check out. (Paper forms can be brought to the Council Service Center if that is easier).

4. Collect the cost of Camp from each family or pack - \$165

5. Visit Samantha at the Council Service Center with the list of scouts and the total amount due (# of scouts x\$165) and pay the registration fees on or before May 6.
