Course Descriptions

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) ✓

At least one leader on a pack overnighter must have completed this all day training to properly understand the importance of program intent, youth protection guidelines, health & safety, site selection, age appropriate activities and sufficient adult participation. Highly recommended for all Den Leaders. (1 ½ day, overnight)

Cub Leader Specific ★✓

Training for Den Leaders & Cubmasters conduct successful meetings, and Committee Members with the basic information they need to support a Pack and conduct a successful Pack program. (2 ½ hrs.)

Fundamentals of Training

Required training for ALL Erie Shores Training Volunteers, unless currently EDGE, Wood Badge Staff or Master Educator trained. Training is intended for both youth and adult trainers. This session is designed to introduce new Scouting trainers to teaching techniques and skills. (4 hrs.)

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) ★★

Outdoor training for Scoutmasters & Asst. Scoutmasters that reviews and teaches the outdoor skills needed in conducting FUN outdoor camping experiences for their units. (1 ½ day, overnight)

Leave No Trace (LNT) Awareness

This course will introduce you to the principles of Leave No Trace. We will teach you the LNT principals and how to apply them to the BSA Outdoor Ethics Program. (3 ½ hrs)

Leave No Trace (LNT) Trainer

Weekend long course that introduces participants to the principals of Leave No Trace and how to apply them and teach them to others. All participants must be at least 14 years old. (2 Day, Overnight)

National Youth Leader Training (NYLT)

Program that will help you develop both leadership skills and communication skills. All participants must be 14 years old or 13 years old and have completed 8th grade; there cannot be any exceptions. Scouts meeting the age requirements must attend Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST). Girls who are registered Venturers do not need to achieve the First Class rank, but must attend Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews (ILSC) prior to participating in NYLT. (5 day, Overnight)

Scoutmaster Specific ★★✓

Location Addresses:

Training will provide an active, fun, and positive learning experience for new and experienced Scoutmasters & Asst.

Scoutmasters to learn and apply proven techniques for running an effective Scout Troop. (4 hrs.)

Trainer's EDGE

Required training for all Erie Shores Training Event Coordinators and Wood Badge, NYLT & Summer Camp Staff. This course is intended to "train the trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media. (8 hrs.)

University of Scouting

Informative (and FUN) day of required, supplemental and advanced training for adult & youth leaders involved with Cub Scouts, Scouts and Venturing programs. Sorry, no classes for Cub Scout aged youth. (Times Vary)

Wilderness First Aid

First aid course for backcountry situations when EMS is not readily available. The course meets the current requirements for those attending any of the BSA High Adventure Camp programs and is recommended for those attending any other High Adventure programs where Scouts or Venturers might be involved. (16 hrs.)

Wood Badge

The ultimate leadership training program for the adult leaders that will teach them the skills they need to strengthen Scouting in meaningful ways. Course attendees begin their Wood Badge experience as Cub Scouts, then bridge into Scouts and form patrols for the remainder of the program. (6 days, Overnight)

Youth Protection (YPT2) ✓

REQUIRED training for all registered leaders. This training is designed to help you keep our youth safe from abuse. This training must be completed before submitting any adult leader application. (2 hrs.)

Youth Protection (YPT2) - Facilitator

Required training for all adult trainers that wish to assist Council with Youth Protection training.
